OAK WILT




- Fungal Disease with no known cure
- Infects all Oak Trees, some species more than others


• Prevalent in Central Texas


• Methods to control and treatments are expensive and not guaranteed

Current Regulatory Practice



City Code, Chapter 21 UDC, Chapter 35

- Tree Maintenance
 License/Insurance
- Wounds treated within 30 minutes
- Oak Wilt infected firewood prohibited from being brought into the City

Penalties

Misdemeanor Offense

- Fine
 - First Offense

\$50 - \$500

Second Offense

\$100 - \$500


