Synopsis:

(Part I) At approximately 0210 hours on October 23rd, 2009, SAPD Officer Matthew Belver #1106 (WPC) arrested Mr. Carlos Flores for Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) at Pinn Rd and Westfield SAPD case #9-0803008. Mr. Flores stated that while handcuffed and in the back seat of Officer Belver's patrol vehicle, he repeatedly begged, then argued for Officer Belver to release him. Mr. Flores alleged that Officer Belver stated "If you can kick my ass, I will let you go" and added that even though he declined Officer Belvers' challenge, Officer Belver allegedly entered the back seat area of the patrol vehicle (where Mr. Flores had been placed by Officer Belver) and repeatedly struck Mr. Flores in the head, arms and back. Mr. Flores admitted kicking Officer Belver, but only because he was scared and was trying to defend himself from Officer Belver's assault. In addition to DWI, Mr. Flores was also charged with Resisting Arrest, Assault on a Public Servant and issued 6 traffic citations.

On December 2nd, 2009, Mr. Flores brought 7 photographs of himself, identifying visible injuries to his left and right facial area, including his cheek and chin as well as his back and upper left shoulder.

(Part II) On January 15^{th.} 2010 Officer Belver responded to the allegation made by Mr. Flores on an Internal Affairs Response Report. Officer Belver denied the allegations, specifying that he used "Open Empty Hand Techniques" to hold down Mr. Flores on the "concrete." Officer Belver added that he never observed any injury on Mr. Flores because arriving officers took control of Mr. Flores and no further contact was made with Mr. Flores by Officer Belver.

Following the answers given by Officer Belver on his Response Report dated January 15th, 2010, two issues were addressed. The first issue was with Officer Belver's claim that he never observed any injury on Mr. Flores, even though photographs (personal, booking, and detention) visually depicted injury to Mr. Flores. Documentation from the date of Mr. Flores' arrest, such as Booking Slips and the Magistrate Intake Form noted "visible injury" on Mr. Flores.

The second issue was a conflict in details on Officer Belver's DWI Report which described that Mr. Flores refused to give a specimen of breath or blood. This was inconsistent with a Response Report by Officer Belver dated January 15th, 2010 in which Officer Belver noted that he had no contact with Mr. Flores once arriving officers had taken control of Mr. Flores. Officer Belver further emphasized not having contact with Mr. Flores because Mr. Flores was transported by the Police Wagon to the SAPD Detention Center and placed in a cell prior to Officer Belver's arrival at the Detention Center.

Allegation #1: On Friday, October 23rd, 2009, SAPD Officer Matthew Belver #1106 (WPC) arrested Mr. Carlos Flores for Driving While Intoxicated at the intersection of Pinn Road and Westfield Drive. Mr. Flores stated that after he had been handcuffed and put in the patrol car, he repeatedly begged Officer Belver to release him. Mr. Flores stated that Officer Belver told him, "If you can kick my ass, I'll let you go." Mr. Flores stated that he declined Officer Belver's offer, but Officer Belver allegedly entered the back seat area where he was seated and repeatedly struck him in the head, arms and back while Mr. Flores was handcuffed.

This conduct may be a violation of the San Antonio Police Department's General Manual:

Rule and Regulation 3.26, Treatment of Prisoners.

TREATMENT OF PRISONERS: Prisoners shall be protected in their legal rights, given humane treatment, and shall not be subjected to verbal abuse or unnecessary physical violence.

Allegation #2: On Friday, October 23rd, 2009, SAPD Officer Matthew Belver #1106 (WPC) arrested Mr. Carlos Flores for Driving While Intoxicated at the intersection of Pinn Road and Westfield Drive (SAPD Case #9-803008). Mr. Flores was transported and booked into the SAPD Detention Center. Mr. Flores alleged that Officer Belver repeatedly struck him, causing injury to his face, neck arms and back. The Magistrate Services/Detention Center Arrested Person Registration /Property Form identified visible injuries at the time of booking and also noted Mr. Flores claimed injury. In addition Mr. Flores was photographed at the SAPD Detention Center approximately 1 hour after his arrest. Facial injuries were visible in this photograph.

The Administration alleges that Officer Belver failed to transport Mr. Flores to 527 North Leona as required for prisoners exhibiting or complaining of minor injury.

This conduct may be a violation of the San Antonio Police Department's General Manual: Procedure 601 Prisoners .14 INJURED / SICK PRISONERS A. Officer Responsibilities

2. Prisoners exhibiting or complaining of minor injury or sickness not requiring immediate medical attention are transported by the arresting officer to the Downtown University Health Care Building located at 527 North Leona or University Hospital, 4502 Medical Drive. Should the arresting officer be involved with other duties, another officer is assigned to transport the prisoner.

Allegation #3: On Friday, October 23rd, 2009, SAPD Officer Matthew Belver #1106 (WPC) arrested Mr. Carlos Flores for Driving While Intoxicated at the intersection of Pinn Road and Westfield Drive (SAPD Case #9-803008). In a DWI Report (SAPD Form 24-1A) written by Officer Belver subsequent to the arrest, Officer Belver reported Mr. Flores refused to provide a specimen of breath or blood. The Administration alleges that Officer Belver was untruthful in his Response Report dated January 15th, 2010. Officer Belver's answer to a question directly conflicted with the details reported by Officer Belver in his original DWI Report dated October 23rd, 2009.

This conduct may be a violation of the San Antonio Police Department's General Manual: Rules and Regulations, section 3.00- Individual Responsibilities, Subsection 3.02-Truthfulness of Members

3.02 TRUTHFULNESS OF MEMBERS: Members shall speak the truth at all times. Reports and written communications from any member shall reflect the truth.
