AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Cathleen M. Garcia:

WHEREAS, Officer Cathleen M. Garcia, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on December 7, 2015, with a one-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Garcia was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against her to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Garcia; and

WHEREAS, Officer Garcia and Chief McManus have agreed that the discipline in this matter shall be a one-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Garcia shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of one day, commencing on January 15, 2016, and ending on January 15, 2016. Should Officer Garcia not be involved in a chargeable traffic accident in the year following the issuance of this agreed suspension, upon application by Officer Garcia within two weeks of such date, and approval by the Chief of Police, this suspension shall be reduced to a written reprimand, and one day's pay and benefits will be returned to Officer Garcia. Officer Garcia waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Garcia has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Garcia and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Garcia has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (A) IMPROPER OR NEGLIGENT HANDLING: Improper or negligent handling of any city property or willful damage to city property is prohibited.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about October 13, 2015, at approximately 3:40 p.m., while on duty and operating a city-owned vehicle in the 7900 block of W. Military Drive, Officer Cathleen M. Garcia negligently struck a light pole.

The level of this suspension is based upon Officer Garcia's cumulative point total for this accident and other chargeable accidents within the twenty-four month period prior to this accident as per Procedure 303,17 of the San Antonio Police Department General Manual.
