AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Sarah Hayhurst:

WHEREAS, Officer Sarah Hayhurst, pursuant to Article XXVII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on October 22, 2014, with a three-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Hayhurst was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against her to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Hayhurst; and

WHEREAS, Officer Hayhurst and Chief McManus have agreed that the discipline in this matter shall be a three-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Hayhurst shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of three days, commencing on December 9, 2014, and ending on December 11, 2014. Should Officer Hayhurst not be involved in a chargeable traffic accident in the year following the issuance of this agreed suspension, upon application by Officer Hayhurst within two weeks of such date, and approval by the Chief of Police, this suspension shall be reduced to a written reprimand, and three days' pay and benefits will be returned to Officer Hayhurst. Officer Hayhurst waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Hayhurst has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Hayhurst and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Hayhurst has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (A) IMPROPER OR NEGLIGENT HANDLING: Improper or negligent handling of any city property or willful damage to city property is prohibited.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

SHAN RESOURCES DEPT

On or about July 25, 2014, at approximately 5:26 a.m., while on duty and operating a city-owned vehicle at the intersection of Woodlawn and N.W. 36th Street, Officer Sarah Hayhurst negligently struck a vehicle.

The level of this suspension is based upon Officer Hayhurst's cumulative point total for this accident and other chargeable accidents within the twenty-four month period prior to this accident as per Procedure 303.16 of the San Antonio Police Department General Manual.

A copy of the instant disciplinary suspension order is being filed with the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission.
