B: Poor Attendance-Excessive absence and / or Tardiness

In addition to the following Bexar County Detention Manual of Policy and Procedure, Paragraph 300:02:

V: A(#03) – A formal written reprimand will be administered on the fourth and fifth offense which has occurred during a ninety day period and within 90 days since the first offense.
