Under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Title 5, Subtitle A, Chapter 143 of the Local Government Code, V.T.C.S., said chapter entitled "Municipal Civil Service", I do hereby suspend Officer Jason Hernandez from paid duty with the San Antonio Police Department for a period of one calendar day, commencing on October 20, 2017, and ending on October 20, 2017.

Officer Hernandez has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rule violated by Officer Hernandez and ground for suspension is as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Hernandez has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (C) SAFE OPERATION OF VEHICLES: City vehicles will be operated in a safe manner and in compliance with all traffic laws.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about August 11, 2017, at approximately 10:59 a.m., while on duty and operating a city-owned vehicle in the 3000 block of W. Woodlawn Avenue, Officer Jason Hernandez negligently struck a vehicle.
