AGREED SUSPENSION

Gentlemen and Detective Josef L. Piotrowski:

WHEREAS, Detective Josef L. Piotrowski, pursuant to Article XXVII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on November 9, 2017, with a ten-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Detective Piotrowski was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Detective Piotrowski; and

WHEREAS, Detective Piotrowski and Chief McManus have agreed that the discipline in this matter shall be a five-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this Agreed Suspension wherein it is provided that Detective Piotrowski shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of one day, commencing on February 19, 2018, and ending on February 19, 2018. The remaining four days of Detective Piotrowski's five-day suspension shall be held in abeyance for a period of one year. Detective Piotrowski shall serve the remaining four days if he has an allegation of similar misconduct which is subsequently sustained within twelve months from the date of July 12, 2017. Detective Piotrowski waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Detective Piotrowski has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Detective Piotrowski and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Detective Piotrowski has violated are as follows:

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about July 12, 2017, while investigating two robberies, Detective Josef L. Piotrowski failed to exhibit the proper respect toward a supervisory officer. Detective Piotrowski reportedly stated, "This is fucked up" and that the supervisors were "messing" with his case. These comments were made to Sergeant Justin Tidwell, and in the presence of other patrol officers.

Further, on or about July 12, 2017, while investigating two robberies, Detective Josef L. Piotrowski failed to show the proper respect toward a supervisory officer. Detective Piotrowski argued with Sergeant John Slaughter about how the investigation should be conducted. During this argument, Detective Piotrowski stated, "That's Bullshit" more than once and, according to Sergeant Slaughter, used an inappropriate tone.

A copy of the instant disciplinary suspension order is being filed with the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission.
