## **AGREED SUSPENSION**

Commissioners and Officer Benjamin I. Jass

WHEREAS, Officer Benjamin I. Jass, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on March 8, 2018, with a one-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Jass was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Jass; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jass and Chief McManus have agreed that the discipline in this matter shall be a one-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Jass shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of one day, commencing on April 12, 2018, and ending on April 12, 2018. Should Officer Jass not be involved in a chargeable traffic accident in the year following February 10, 2018, upon application by Officer Jass within two weeks of such date, and approval by the Chief of Police, one day's pay and benefits will be returned to Officer Jass. Officer Jass waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Jass has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Jass and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Jass has violated are as follows:

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about February 10, 2018, at approximately 4:20 p.m., while on duty and operating a city-owned vehicle in the 1100 block of N.E. Loop 410 access road, Officer Benjamin I. Jass negligently struck a vehicle.

The level of this suspension is based upon Officer Jass's cumulative point total for this accident and other chargeable accidents within the twenty-four month period prior to this accident as per Procedure 303.17 of the San Antonio Police Department General Manual.
