AGREED SUSPENSION

Gentlemen and Officer Austin T. Wilke:

WHEREAS, Officer Austin T. Wilke, pursuant to Article XXVII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on February 24, 2018, with a contemplated five-day suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Wilke was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Wilke; and

WHEREAS, Officer Wilke and Chief McManus have agreed that the discipline in this matter shall be a five-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Wilke shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of two days, commencing on April 6, 2018, and ending on April 7, 2018. The remaining three days of Officer Wilke's five-day suspension shall be held in abeyance for a period of one year. If Officer Wilke is not involved in a chargeable accident for a period of one year commencing on January 15, 2018, the remaining three days will be vacated, and he will receive one day back from the two-day suspension he will serve from April 6, 2018 through April 7, 2018. Officer Wilke waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Wilke has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Wilke and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Wilke has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (C) SAFE OPERATION OF VEHICLES: City vehicles will be operated in a safe manner and in compliance with all traffic laws.
