AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Paul A. Trigo:

WHEREAS, Officer Paul A. Trigo, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on February 12, 2018, with a three-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Trigo was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Trigo; and

WHEREAS, Officer Trigo and his captain, Patrick Murnin, have agreed and Chief McManus has approved of settling this matter with a three-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Trigo shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of three days, commencing on March 18, 2018, and ending on March 20, 2018. Officer Trigo waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Trigo has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Trigo and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Trigo has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.04 - RESPONSIBILITY TO SERVE THE PUBLIC (C) CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR: Members, on-or off-duty, shall be governed by the ordinary and reasonable rules of good conduct and behavior, and shall not commit any act tending to bring reproach or discredit on themselves or the department.

PROCEDURE 313 – USE OF CITY VEHICLES (.04) AUTHORIZED USE (B) Members transport only authorized persons in a city vehicle.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about January 28, 2018, at approximately 5:05 p.m., Sergeant Monica Tedford observed Officer Paul A. Trigo's marked SAPD K9 vehicle parked in front of a vacant building located at 8364 Laser Road, behind the ITSD/Communications building. Sergeant Tedford then observed Officer Trigo and a female civilian employee walking towards the building. Sergeant Tedford then contacted Officer Trigo as he opened the front door of the building from inside after Sergeant Tedford observed him and the civilian inside the building. Upon questioning Officer Trigo's actions, he identified that the civilian was a friend and city employee who worked at Communications and that he had given her a ride from the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) in his assigned marked SAPD K9 vehicle. The city employee was immediately returned to the PSAP.

A copy of the instant disciplinary suspension order is being filed with the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission.
