AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Hilario Flores:

WHEREAS, Officer Hilario Flores, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on November 14, 2017, with a one-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Flores was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Flores; and

WHEREAS, Officer Flores and his captain, Vidal Resendez, have agreed and Chief McManus has approved of settling this matter with a one-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Flores shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of one day, commencing on December 9, 2017, and ending on December 9, 2017. Officer Flores waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Flores has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Flores and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Flores has violated are as follows:

RULE 4.16 - ABSENCE FROM ASSIGNMENT: Members shall not leave their beats or assigned areas except in the line-of-duty, upon authorization of a supervisor, or at the end of a scheduled tour-of-duty.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

Officer Hilario Flores was on the worksheets for October 21, 2017. Sergeant Tobias remembered that Officer Flores had mentioned he was going out of town beforehand. Sergeant Tobias looked at the red book and saw Officer Flores was not listed nor approved in the red book to be off on October 21, 2017. Sergeant Tobias called Officer Flores and he did not answer. Officer Flores texted Sergeant Tobias, and Sergeant Tobias responded by asking him if he was coming in to work. Officer Flores said he thought he was in the red book. Sergeant Tobias advised him that he was not and sent him a picture of the red book page in question. Officer Flores called in sick to the service agent at 1:00 p.m. on October 21, 2017.

I do hereby waive any and all rights to appeal said suspension and no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review same or alter its terms.
