## AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Isaac L. Botello:

WHEREAS, Officer Isaac L. Botello, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on May 19, 2018, with a three-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Botello was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Botello; and

WHEREAS, Officer Botello and Chief McManus have agreed that the discipline in this matter shall be a three-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Botello shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of three days, commencing on July 11, 2018, and ending on July 13, 2018. Should Officer Botello not be involved in a chargeable traffic accident in the year following February 25, 2018, upon application by Officer Botello within two weeks of such date, and approval by the Chief of Police, two days' pay and benefits will be returned to Officer Botello. Officer Botello waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Botello has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Botello and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Botello has violated are as follows:

> RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (C) SAFE OPERATION OF VEHICLES: City vehicles will be operated in a safe manner and in compliance with all traffic laws.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about February 25, 2018, at approximately 9:32 p.m., while on duty and operating a city-owned vehicle in the 7100 block of Five Palms Drive, Officer Isaac L. Botello negligently struck a vehicle.

The level of this suspension is based upon Officer Botello's cumulative point total for this accident and other chargeable accidents within the twenty-four month period prior to this accident as per Procedure 303.17 of the San Antonio Police Department General Manual.

A copy of the instant disciplinary suspension order is being filed with the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission.
