## AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Gerald Rodriguez:

WHEREAS, Officer Gerald Rodriguez, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on August 13, 2018, with a three-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, Officer Rodriguez and his captain, Randall Smith, have agreed and Chief McManus has approved of settling this matter with a three-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Rodriguez shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of three days, commencing on September 10, 2018, and ending on September 12, 2018. Officer Rodriguez waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Rodriguez has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Rodriguez and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Rodriguez has violated are as follows:

RULE 4.03 - REQUIREMENT TO TAKE ACTION: On-duty members are required to take prompt and effective police action conforming to departmental policies with respect to violations of laws and ordinances and matters affecting public safety coming to their attention, or of which they have knowledge.

RULE 4.09 - DUTY TO REPORT CRIMES: Members receiving or possessing facts or information relative to a criminal offense shall not conceal, ignore, distort, or retain such facts or information, and will report such facts. Members will have a continuing duty to report facts and information relative to criminal offenses until the criminal offense has been reported through proper channels.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about June 14, 2018, Officer Gerald Rodriguez was dispatched to a family disturbance call involving a brother and sister. When Officer Rodriguez arrived at the residence, he was told by the brother (complainant) that his sister had a warrant. Officer Rodriguez proceeded to get the sister's name and date of birth and was even told by the sister herself that she had missed a court date. Despite this information, Officer Rodriguez failed to conduct a warrant check and failed to arrest the sister, who had an active warrant for Assault Family Violence.
