Commissioners and Probationary Officer Tyler R. Stenson:

Under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Title 5, Subtitle A, Chapter 143 of the Local Government Code, V.T.C.S., said chapter entitled "Municipal Civil Service", I do hereby suspend Probationary Officer Tyler R. Stenson from paid duty with the San Antonio Police Department for a period of three calendar days, commencing on October 18, 2018, and ending on October 20, 2018.

Probationary Officer Stenson has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rule violated by Probationary Officer Stenson and ground for suspension is as follows:

- (12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations of the San Antonio Police Department which Probationary Officer Stenson has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (C) SAFE OPERATION OF VEHICLES: City vehicles will be operated in a safe manner and in compliance with all traffic laws.


The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about August 8, 2018, at approximately 6:35 p.m., while on duty and operating a city-owned vehicle at the intersection of San Fernando Street and S.W. 30th Street, Probationary Officer Tyler R. Stenson negligently collided with a vehicle.

The level of this suspension is based upon Probationary Officer Stenson's cumulative point total for this accident and other chargeable accidents within the twenty-four month period prior to this accident as per Procedure 303.17 of the San Antonio Police Department General Manual.


