Commissioners and Officer Josue G. Vallejo-Martinez:

WHEREAS, Officer Josue G. Vallejo-Martinez, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers? OF Association, was served on October 5, 2018, with a seventeen-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Officer Vallejo-Martinez was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Officer Vallejo-Martinez; and

WHEREAS, Officer Vallejo-Martinez and Chief McManus have agreed to reduce the discipline in this matter to a ten-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Vallejo-Martinez shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of ten days, commencing on November 9, 2018, and ending on November 18, 2018. Officer Vallejo-Martinez waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Vallejo-Martinez has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Vallejo-Martinez and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Vallejo-Martinez has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (C) SAFE OPERATION OF VEHICLES: City vehicles will be operated in a safe manner and in compliance with all traffic laws.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On April 30, 2018, at approximately 2:21 p.m., Officer Josue G. Vallejo-Martinez, #1345 (WPB) was dispatched to a call for an accident at 7614 Marbach Road, San Antonio, Texas. While enroute to the accident, Officer Vallejo-Martinez drove in a reckless and unsafe manner by

disregarding traffic laws and by driving through an active school zone above the posted speed limit. It is alleged by the Administration that Officer Vallejo-Martinez did not operate his marked SAPD patrol vehicle in a safe manner and in compliance with all traffic laws. This incident was handled under SAPD 18089370.
