Commissioners and Lieutenant Matthew J. Golla:

Under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Title 5, Subtitle A, Chapter 143 of the Local Government Code, V.T.C.S., said chapter entitled "Municipal Civil Service", I do hereby suspend Lieutenant Matthew J. Golla from paid duty with the San Antonio Police Department for a period of thirty calendar days, commencing on October 30, 2018, and ending on November 28, 2018.

Lieutenant Golla has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rule violated by Lieutenant Golla and ground for suspension is as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations of the San Antonio Police Department which Lieutenant Golla has violated are as follows:

RULE 3:04 - RESPONSIBILITY TO SERVE THE PUBLIC (C) CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR: Members, on-or off-duty, shall be governed by the ordinary and reasonable rules of good conduct and behavior, and shall not commit any act tending to bring reproach or discredit on themselves or the department.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On March 23, 2018, Lieutenant Matthew J. Golla was mowing his lawn located at when Kirby Police Officers arrived to investigate a claim of damage to a vehicle from rocks allegedly thrown by Lieutenant Golla's lawnmower. Lieutenant Golla did not cooperate with the police investigation and exhibited an unprofessional and aggressive attitude with the officers. Lieutenant Golla's actions did not conform to the ordinary and reasonable rules of good conduct and behavior and/or brought reproach and discredit to himself and the
