AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Steven D. Martinez:

WHEREAS, Officer Steven D. Martinez, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on September 20, 2018, with a one-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, Officer Martinez and his acting captain, Genaro Villarreal, have agreed and Chief McManus has approved of settling this matter with a one-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Martinez shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of one day, commencing on October 11, 2018, and ending on October 11, 2018. Officer Martinez waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Martinez has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Martinez and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Martinez has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.04 - RESPONSIBILITY TO SERVE THE PUBLIC (C) CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR: Members, on-or off-duty, shall be governed by the ordinary and reasonable rules of good conduct and behavior, and shall not commit any act tending to bring reproach or discredit on themselves or the department.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about November 28, 2017, Officer Steven D. Martinez wrote a check for \$109 to a business. There were insufficient funds in Officer Martinez's checking account and the check was returned. A warrant for Theft by Check \$100 - \$750 was issued for Officer Martinez's arrest. Though Officer Martinez never received notices regarding the returned

check, he failed to look after his personal finances, which may have prevented Officer Martinez's subsequent arrest on September 16, 2018.

A copy of the instant disciplinary suspension order is being filed with the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission.
