The particular civil service rule violated by Officer Cruz and ground for suspension is as follows:

> Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or (12)special order.

The Rules and Regulations of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Cruz has violated are as follows:

> RULE 3.18 - CITY EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (C) SAFE OPERATION OF VEHICLES: City vehicles will be operated in a safe manner and in compliance with all traffic laws.
