AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Detective Bernardo Torres:

WHEREAS, Detective Bernardo Torres, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on September 21, 2018, with a contemplated indefinite suspension; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said contract, Detective Torres was given an opportunity to rebut those charges being brought against him to Police Chief William P. McManus; and

WHEREAS, said opportunity was exercised by Detective Torres; and

WHEREAS, Detective Torres Chief McManus have agreed to reduce the discipline in this matter to a forty-five-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Detective Torres shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of forty-five days, commencing on March 23, 2019, and ending on May 6, 2019. Detective Torres waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Detective Torres has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Detective Torres and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Detective Torres has violated are as follows:

RULE 3.04 – RESPONSIBILITY TO SERVE THE PUBLIC: Members shall serve the public through direction, counseling, assistance and protection of life and property. Members shall also respect the rights of individuals and perform their services with honesty, sincerity, courage, and sound judgment. (C) CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR: Members, on-or off-duty, shall be governed by the ordinary and reasonable rules of good conduct and behavior, and shall not commit any act tending to bring reproach or discredit on themselves or the department.

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

It is alleged by the Administration (based on information provided by an on-duty San Antonio Independent School District police officer) on April 24, 2018, at approximately 11:51 p.m., off-duty SAPD Detective Bernardo Torres, #2265
