## AGREED SUSPENSION

Commissioners and Officer Eddie S. Chavez:

WHEREAS, Officer Eddie S. Chavez, pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, was served on April 24, 2019, with a one-day contemplated suspension; and

WHEREAS, Officer Chavez and his captain, Randall Smith, have agreed and Chief McManus has approved of settling this matter with a one-day suspension without pay; NOW THEREFORE:

The undersigned parties hereby enter into this suspension agreement wherein it is provided that Officer Chavez shall be suspended without pay from the San Antonio Police Department for a period of one day, commencing on May 19, 2019, and ending on May 19, 2019. Officer Chavez waives any rights to appeal this Agreed Suspension and agrees no administrative or judicial body shall have power to review this Agreed Suspension or alter the terms of this agreement.

Officer Chavez has violated Subsection C of Rule XIII of the City of San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules, said rules having been adopted on February 23, 1998, and thereafter from time to time amended, by the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission as the Civil Service Rules for the Fire and Police Departments of the City of San Antonio. The particular civil service rules violated by Officer Chavez and grounds for suspension are as follows:

(12) Violation of an applicable fire or police department rule or special order.

The Rules and Regulations and Procedures of the San Antonio Police Department which Officer Chavez has violated are as follows:

PROCEDURE 506 - TRAFFIC LAW ENFORCEMENT (.08) SPECIAL TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES (F) Drivers with No Valid Driver's License (1) Drivers found to be operating motor vehicles without valid driver's licenses are arrested for the offense, except: (b) If a person does not have a valid driver's license but does have evidence of



financial responsibility on the vehicle: (1) If there is a passenger in the vehicle with a valid driver's license, the person with the valid driver's license will be allowed to remove the vehicle; (2) The driver will be allowed thirty (30) minutes (from the time the traffic stop initiated) to arrange for another driver with a valid driver's license to remove the vehicle; (3) If a licensed driver is not available within the allotted thirty (30) minute time frame, the vehicle will be impounded; (4) Failure to provide evidence of financial responsibility provides the officer authority to impound the vehicle. (TTC 601.051 - 601.124)

The factual basis for the instant disciplinary suspension is as follows:

On or about March 20, 2019, Officer Eddie S. Chavez handled a motor vehicle crash involving Mr. Castro, who had a suspended driver's license. Mr. Castro also had a previous conviction for Driving While License is Invalid (DWLI), making the offense a class B misdemeanor. Officer Chavez, knowing Mr. Castro had a suspended driver's license, issued him a class C traffic citation and allowed him to drive on a public road.
